

Bill of Rights

I	Right to free speech.
II	Right to keep and bear arms.
III	Prevents the government from billeting soldiers in people's homes.
IV	Prohibits the government from unreasonably searching and seizing an individual and their private property.
V	Right to due process of the law.
VI	Right to a fair trial.
VII	Right to trial by jury.
VIII	Prohibition of cruel and unusual punishments.
IX	Recognition that people's rights are not limited to what is written down in the Constitution.
X	Powers not delegated to the federal government belong to either the state governments or the people.
